

Executive Airborne Solutions Inc. (EAS) assembles wiring harnesses, and installs and tests complete Command, Control, Communications, Computer and Information (C4I) systems for its government customers. EAS understands and is committed to complying with the requirements regarding the use of Conflict Minerals under Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act. As EAS is not a publicly traded company, our compliance is not required but we voluntarily choose to do so.

While EAS does not manufacture any products with raw components that could potentially include Conflict Minerals, the Company does procure wire to be stamped/labeled for inclusion in assembled harnesses. The majority of the components for the complete solution are provided to EAS by the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) who would retain the obligation to ensure no Conflict Minerals were used.

The EAS wire suppliers all have statements/policies on their web sites describing the steps they have taken or are taking to ensure their raw material suppliers are not using Conflict Minerals. In all cases, these suppliers have already received or are in the process of receiving assurances that none of their suppliers source materials from conflict areas.
